

SCUBA DIVING MEDICAL STATEMENT

Please read carefully before signing.

This is a statement in which you are informed of some potential risks involved in scuba diving and of the conduct required of you during scuba diving. Your signature on this statement is required in order to participate in a scuba diving program and/or scuba diving (only for certified divers with internationally recognized scuba diving certificate) or any other scuba diving activities offered by The Dive Tribe Ltd.

Read this statement and fill the form related to your medical history prior to signing it. If you are a minor, you must have this statement signed by a parent or guardian.

Scuba diving is an exciting and demanding activity. When performed correctly, applying correct techniques, it is very safe. When established safety procedures are not followed, however, there are increased risks. To scuba dive safely, you should not be extremely overweight or out of condition. Diving can be strenuous under certain conditions. Your respiratory and circulatory systems must be in good health. All body air spaces must be normal and healthy. A person with coronary disease, a current cold or congestion, epilepsy, a severe medical problem or who is under the influence of drugs or alcohol should not dive. If taking medication consult a doctor and the instructor before participating in the scuba diving training and/or scuba diving.

THE DIVE TRIBE SAFETY RULES

- **Do not exceed 30 meters depth, do any decompression dives or dive alone unless you are certified and equipped for these special activities.**
- **Follow the briefings of your dive guide carefully – respect depth limits and dive plans and never exceed the limits of your training, experience or equipment. Your dive guide's advice is aimed at ensuring your safety and enjoyment.**
- **Don't touch the corals (dead or alive) for any reason.**
- **Don't touch or feed marine life.**
- **Don't remove any memorabilia from shipwrecks.**
- **Spear fishing is prohibited in the red sea.**
- **For the sake of the environment, diving gloves are prohibited in the Red Sea**
- **Don't surface with less than 30 bars in your tank**

LIABILITY RELEASE AND EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I hereby affirm that I have been advised and informed of the inherent hazards of scuba diving. I understand and agree that neither my instructor(s), The Dive Tribe Ltd. (the facility through which I receive my instruction, I scuba dive) nor PADI, nor any of the respective employees, officers, agents or assigns, may be held responsible in any way for any injury, death, or other damages to me or my family, heirs, or assigns, that may occur as a result of my participation in this diving program. I further state that I am of lawful age and legally competent to sign this liability release, or that I have acquired the written consent of my parent or guardian. I understand that the terms herein are contractual and not a mere recital; and I have signed this document of my own free act. I further state that I accept The Dive Tribe Ltd. safety rules. I understand that breach of The Dive Tribe Ltd. safety rules may incur a fine, a prohibition on diving, or both.

The information I have provided about my medical history is accurate to the best of my knowledge. I agree to accept responsibility for omissions regarding my failure to disclose any existing or past health condition.
